



How to crochet puff cloud Tote Bag

Pattern

DC2TOG (DOUBLE CROCHET 2 STITCHES TOGETHER)

SC (SINGLE CROCHET)

HDC (HALF DOUBLE CROCHET)

DC (DOUBLE CROCHET)

FPDC (FRONT POST DOUBLE CROCHET)

BPDC (BACK POST DOUBLE CROCHET)

MR (MAGIC RING)

SK (SKIP)

ST (STITCH)

SL ST (SLIP STITCH)

CH (CHAIN)

POP (POPCORN STITCH)

Measurement : 23cm length 34cm width

600g 8ply White Yarn

(Milk cotton Yarn)

4.00mm Hook Size

Stitch Marker

scissors

Needle

8ply Yarn Details:

Strand: 8 ply

Material : Cotton

Yarn Diameter: 3 mm

Weight: 100g±/piece/per roll

FLAT BASE

ROUND 1 0:46

*Work in the round

(68 dc total around)

- Make a Slip knot
- Chain 32
- Skip 2 Chain (1st&2nd chain from the hook)
- Make 3 dc into the 3rd chain
- Make 1 dc into the next 28 Chains
- Make 6 dc into the last chain
- Make 1 dc into the next 28 stitch
- Add 3 more dc into the 3rd stitch
- Slip stitch

ROUND 2 3:47

*work in the round

(80 dc total around)

- Chain 2
- Make 2 dc into the next 3 stitch (6 dc total)
- Make 1 dc into the next 28 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the next 6 stitch

(12 dc total)

- Make 1 dc into the next 28 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the next 3 stitch

(6 dc Total)

- Slip stitch

ROUND 3 6:22

*work in the round

(104 dc total around)

- Chain 2
- Make 2 dc into the next 6 stitch

(12 dc Total)

- Make 1 dc into the next 28 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the next 12 stitch

(24 dc total)

- Make 1 dc into the next 28 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the next 6 stitch

(12 dc total)

- Slip stitch

ROW 1 8:42

- Chain 3 (Count as 1st dc)
- Make 4 dc into the same stitch
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (the chain 3)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the same stitch
- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 5 dc into the next stitch
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch

(repeat the process around)

*5dc pop, sk 1 st, 2 dc, sk 1 st

*on the last round

- slip stitch into the 1st dc (the chain 3)

ROW 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16,18,20,22 13:29

- Chain 1
- Make 1 sc into each stitch around
- Slip stitch into the 1st sc

ROW 3,5,7,9,11,13,15,17,19,21 15:16

- slip stitch again into the 2nd sc
- Chain 3 (Count as 1st dc)
- Make 4 dc into the same stitch
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (the chain 3)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 2 dc into the same stitch
- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 5 dc into the next stitch
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch

(repeat the process around)

*5dc pop, sk 1 st, 2 dc, sk 1 st

*on the last round

- slip stitch into the 1st dc (the chain 3)

BAG STRAP

ROW 1 21:23

*ch3, 5dc pop, sl st, sk 1 st, 2 dc, sk 1 st, 5dc pop, sl st, 1dc

- Attach the yarn (on the top side of the bag)
- Chain 3
- Make 5 dc into the next stitch
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 2 dc

- Skip 1 stitch
- Make 5 dc
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Make 1 dc

ROW 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16,18,20,22,24,26,28,30,32,34,36,38 25:11

- Chain 1
- Turn the work over
- Make 1 sc 6 times

(6 sc total)

ROW 3,5,7,9,11,13,15,17,19,21,23,25,27,29,31,33,35,37 26:27

*ch3, 5dc pop, sl st, 1dc, 1dc, 5dc pop, sl st, 1dc

- Chain 3
- Turn the work over
- Make 5 dc
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Make 1 dc into the next 2 stitch
- Make 5 dc
- Pull the hook out of the loop
- insert the hook into 1st dc (from the 5 dc)
- Draw the loop into the 1st dc
- Slip stitch
- Make 1 dc into the last stitch

LAST ROUND 31:08

- Cut and secure the yarn
- Sew in the bag straps
- Secure the yarn
