

mesh heart top ♥

Materials: 5mm hook, size 4 yarn, scissors

Hi guys! This top is based on @guppycrochet's tiktok. I thought I'd share how I recreated it so you can make it too!

some notes: this pattern is 17 squares across, but you can adjust the sizing accordingly. If you choose to adjust the number of squares, pick an odd number so that the heart can be centered. keep in mind that the panels are tied together on the sides, so sizing can be adjusted there as well. have fun <3

Pattern: front

Base

Row 1: ch 53

Row 2: sc 52

Main Panel

Row 1-6:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 16

Row 7:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 7
Dc 3 times
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 8

Row 8:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 6
Dc 9 times
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 7

Row 9:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 5
dc 15 times
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 6

Row 10:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 4
ch 1, skip 1, dc 18 times
ch 1, skip 1, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 5

Row 11:

Repeat steps for row 10

Row 12:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 5
dc 15 times
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 6

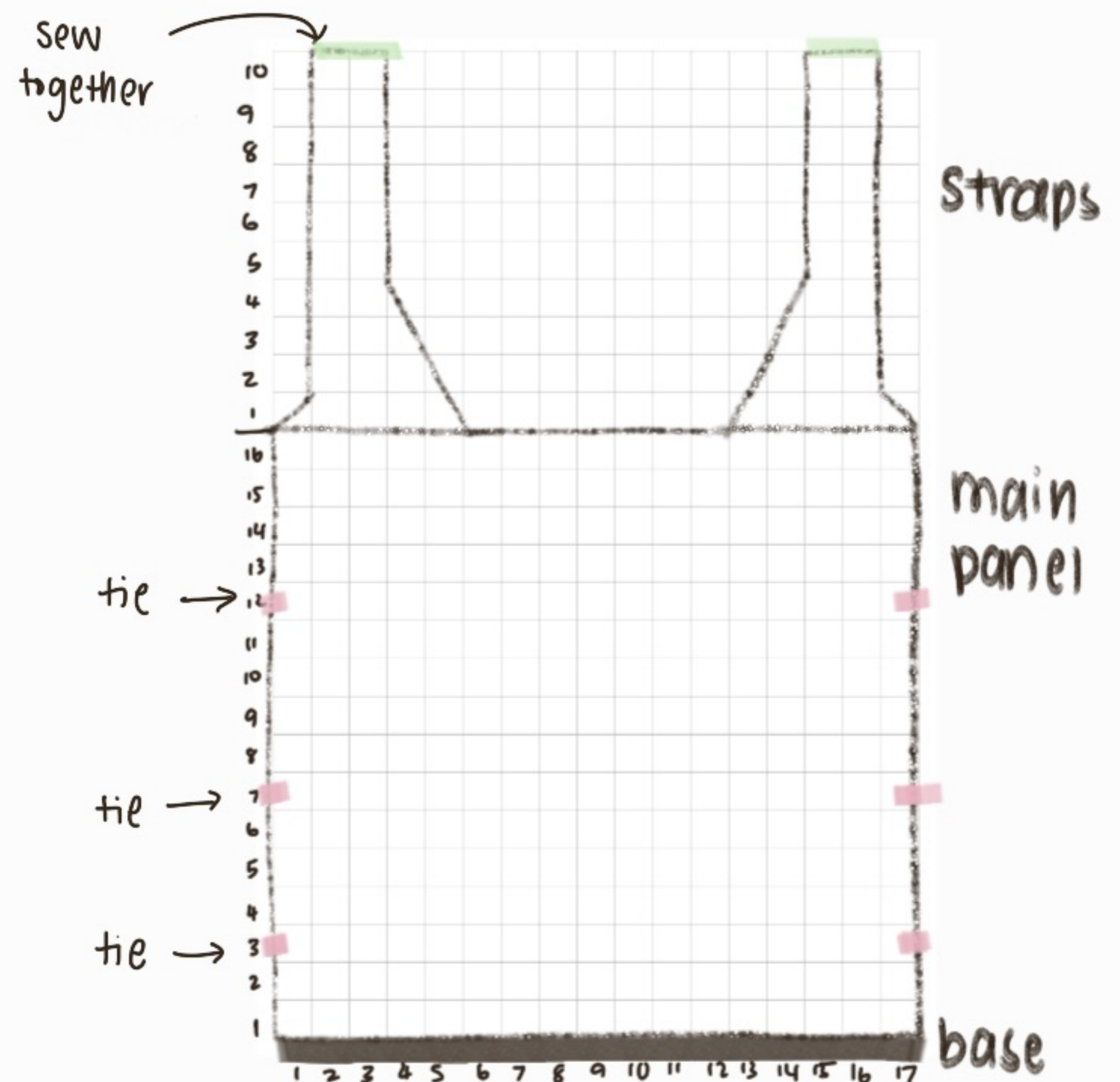
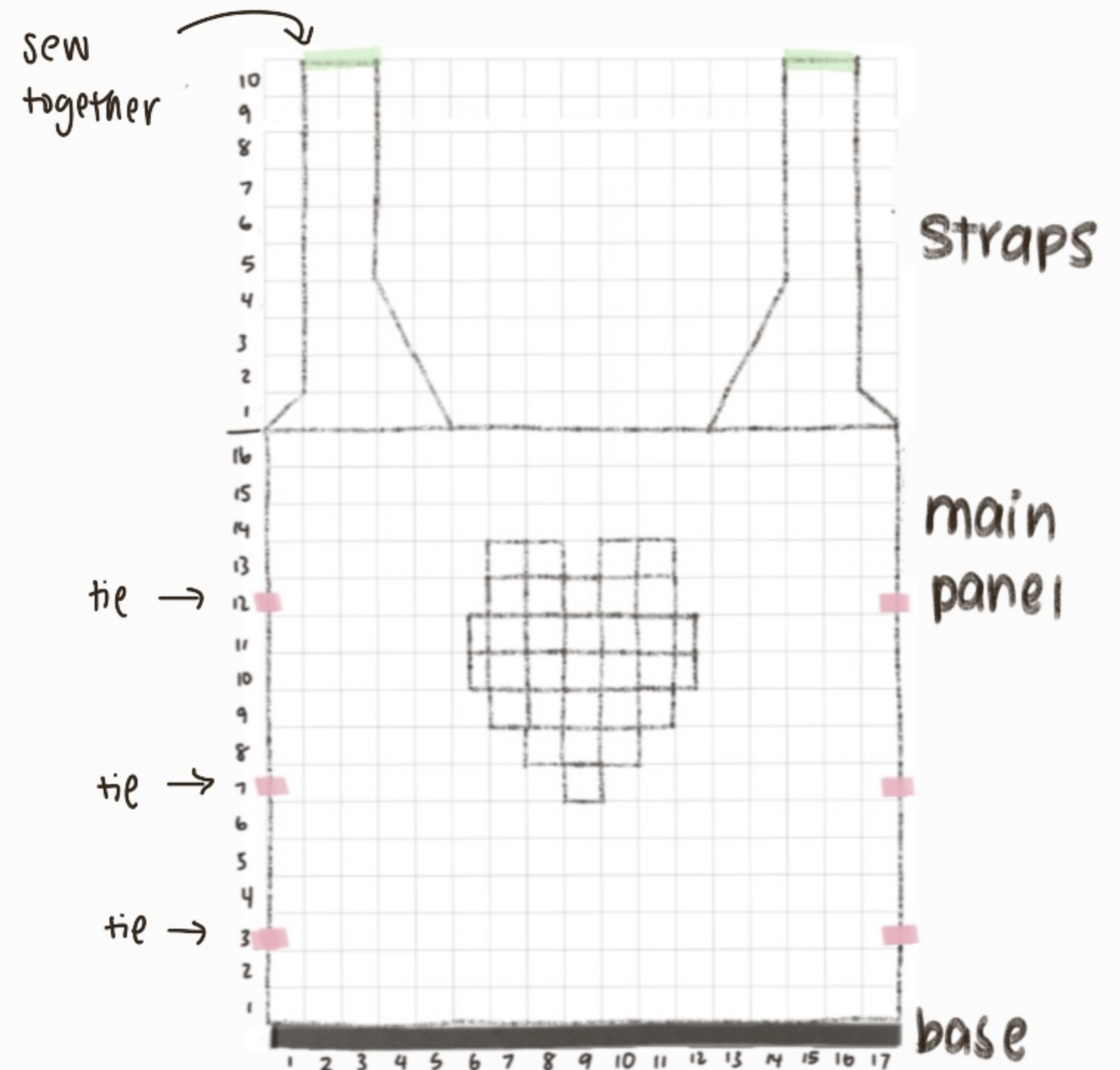
Row 13:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 5
dc 6 times, ch 2,
skip 2, dc 7 times
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 6

Row 14-16:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 16

heart design

mesh heart top ♥

straps

*start at the top corner of the panel

Row 1:

ch 2, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 3
ch 1, skip 2, dc

Row 2:

ch 2, skip 1, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 3

Row 3:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
ch 2, skip 2, dc
ch 1, skip 2, dc

Row 4:

ch 2, skip 1, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 2

Row 5-10:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
ch 2, skip 2, dc

Tie off

*Flip panel and repeat rows 1-10 after attaching yarn to the other corner

Back

Base

Row 1: ch 53 Row 2: sc 52

Main Panel

Row 1-16:

ch 5, skip 2, dc
[ch 2, skip 2, dc] x 16

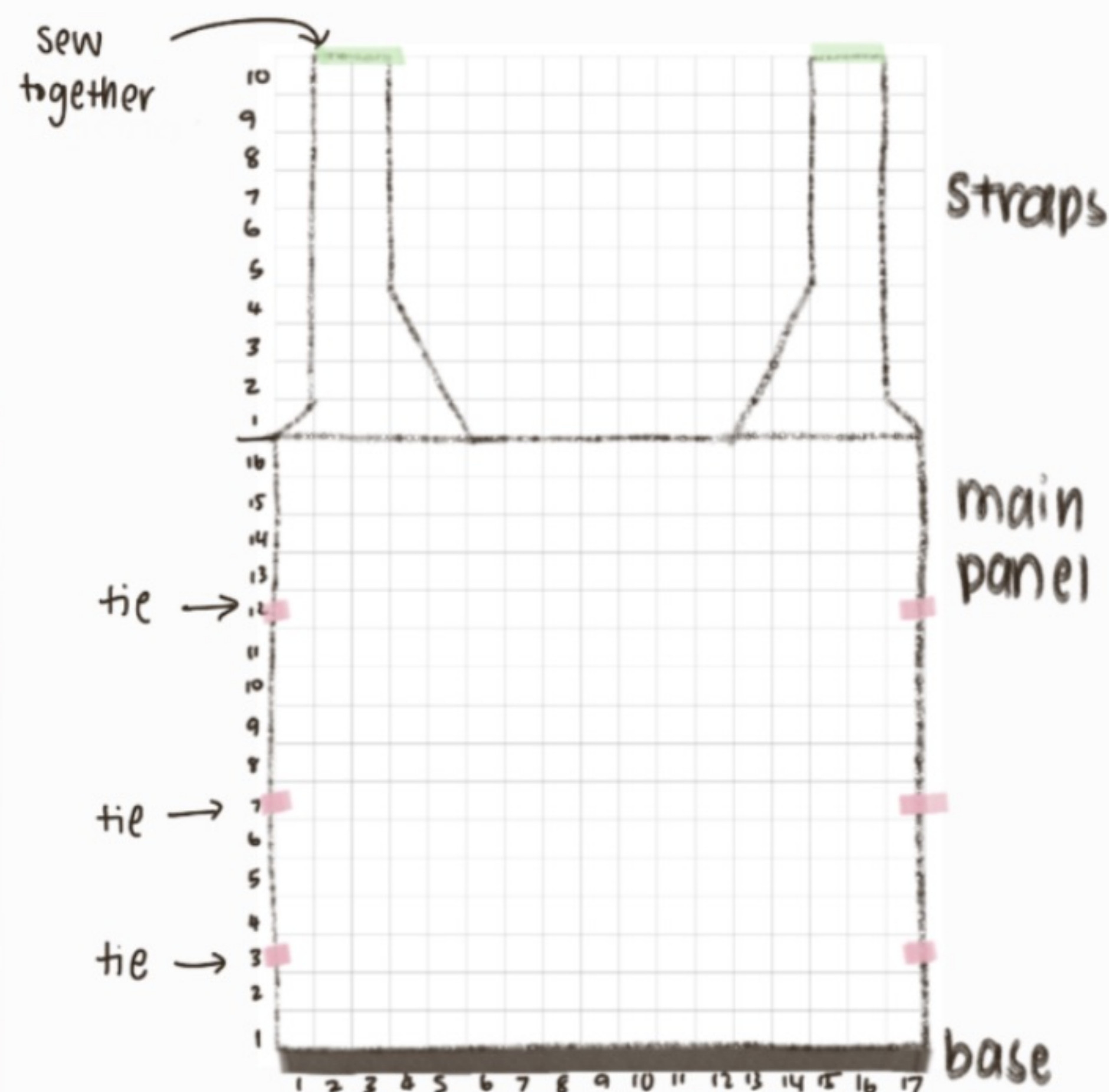
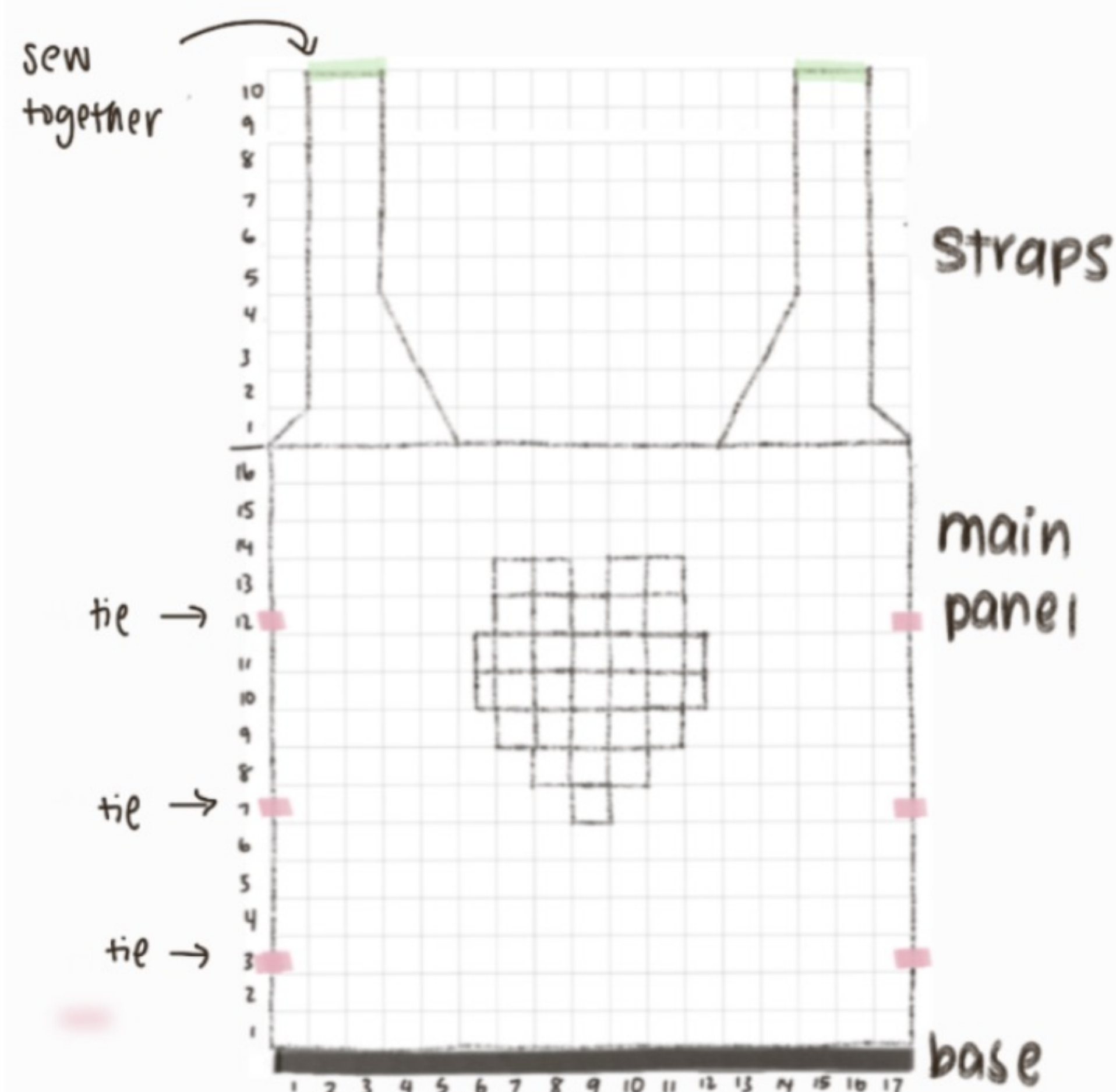
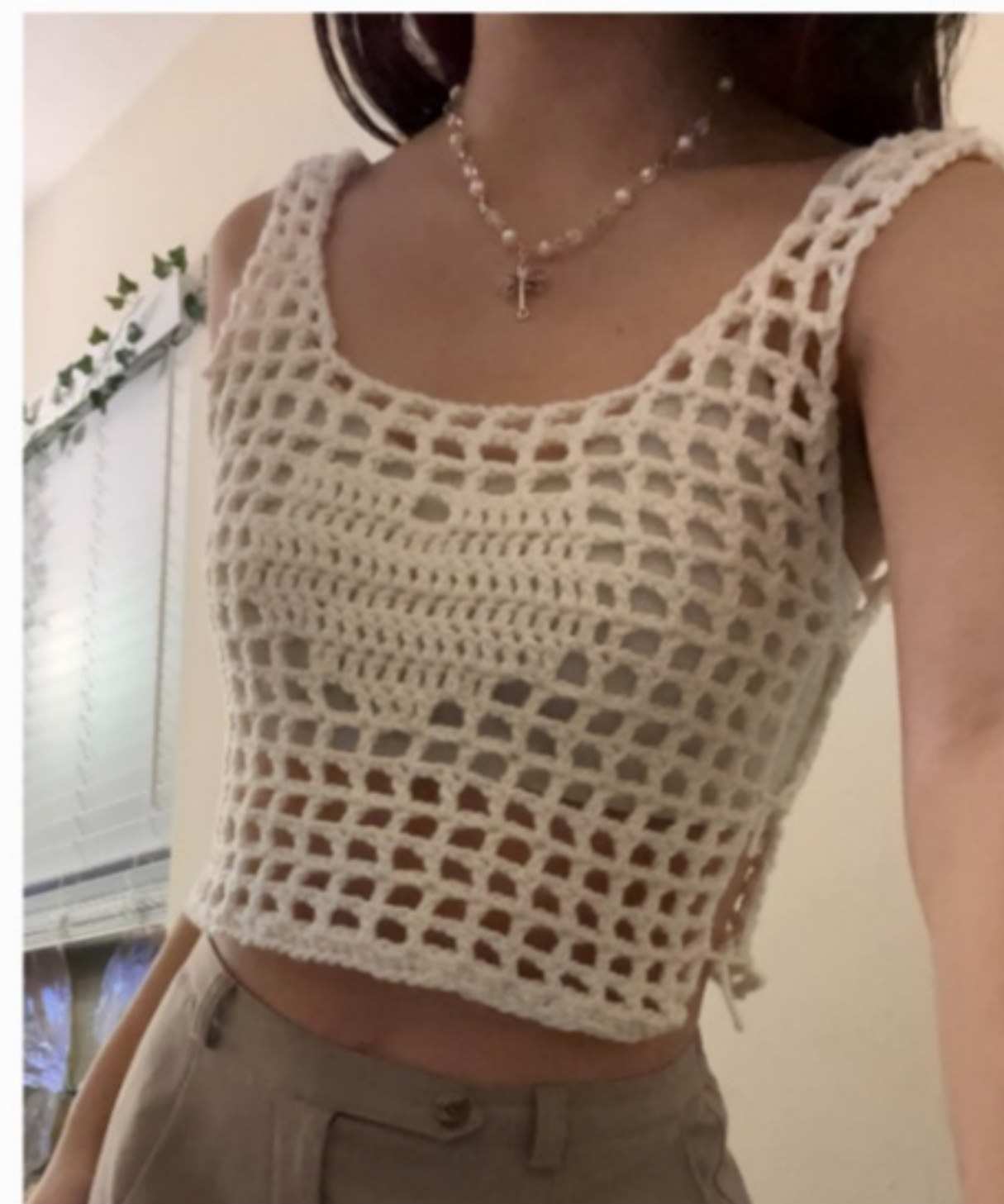
Putting it together

- > Place front and back panels on top of each other
- > sew the straps together
- > Cut 6 pieces of yarn
- > Tie together the 3rd, 7th, and 12th squares (see diagram)

Adjusting the size:

$4 + (3 \times (n-1))$, where n = number of squares

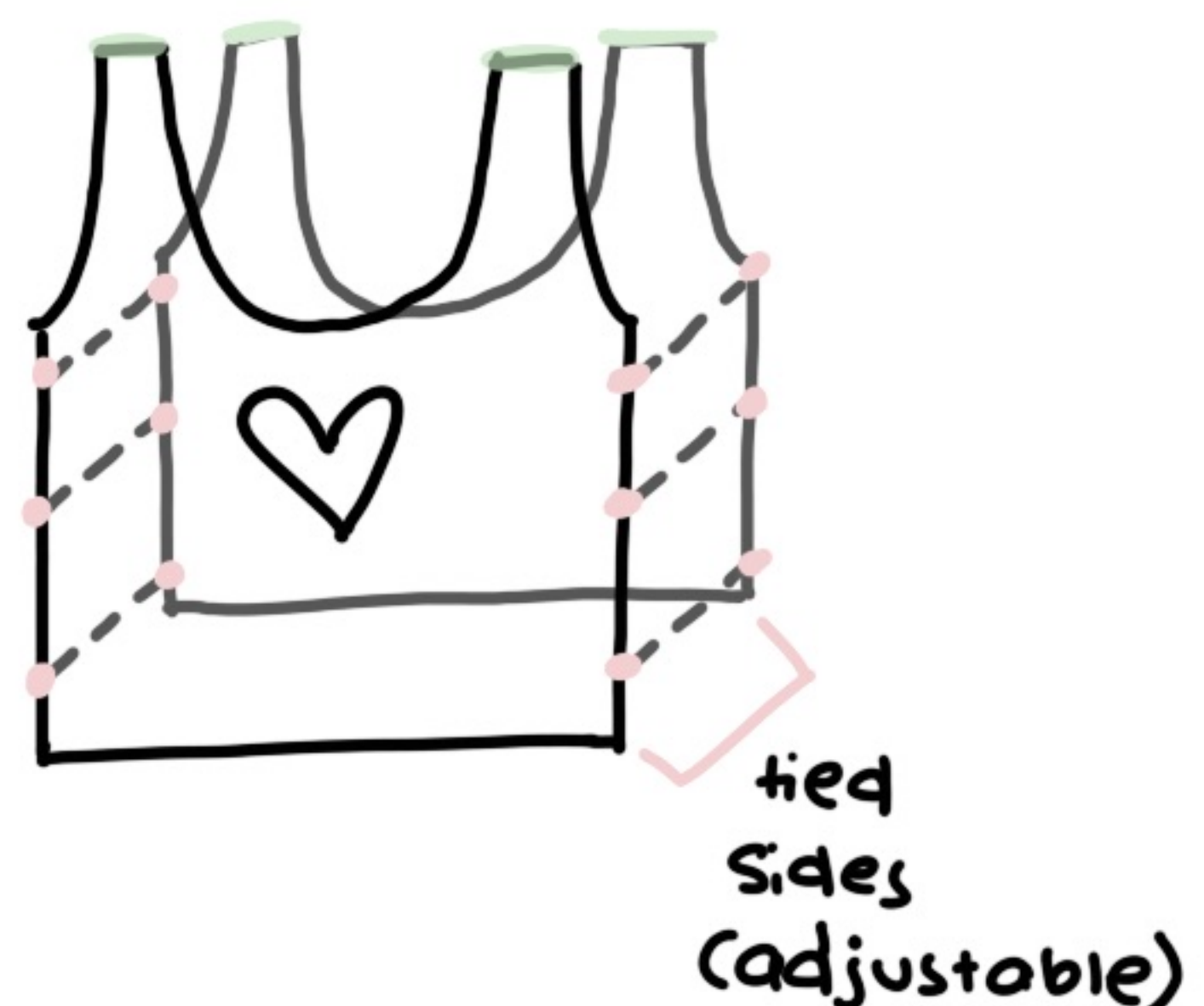
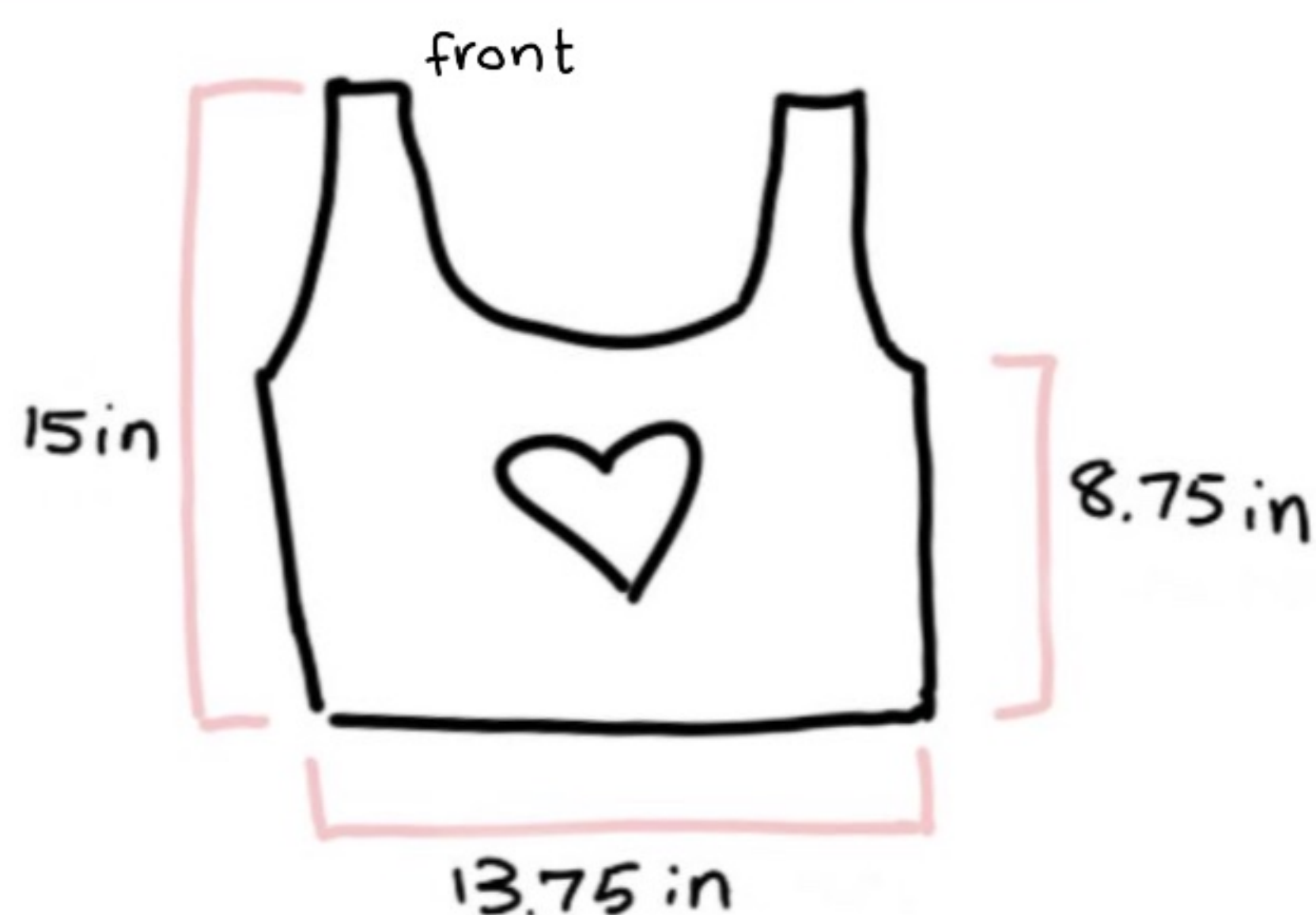
stitches for row one	# of squares (must be an odd number)
40 + 1	13
46 + 1	15
52 + 1	17 **this pattern
58 + 1	19
64 + 1	21
70 + 1	23
...	...

- each change is +/- 1 square from each side of the pattern
- Tip: slip stitch to desired length when holding against your waist. Round that number to the closest # in the "stitches for row one" column
- When doing the heart design, center it in the middle. The number of stitches when filling in the heart remains the same, the only thing changing when you tweak the size is the number of squares on each side of the heart.
- The bottom of the heart starts right below the bust; if you want to change the length of the top, add/remove rows before the heart design
- Keep in mind that crochet is stretchy and you can adjust the side ties!
- Msg me with questions, I know this can be confusing

What yarn/hook did you use?

- impeccable yarn by loops & threads- size 4, 5mm hook. I used about half the ball of yarn ~60 grams
